



STRATEGIC ENGAGEMENT WITH PARTNERS AND EMBASSIES/HIGH COMMISSIONS

In continuation with its strategic engagement with partners and embassies/High Commissions, Commissioners of the Human Rights Commission of Sierra Leone on Thursday January 23 engaged the Nigerian High Commissioner to Sierra Leone and staff at Hill Cot road, Freetown.

The Chairperson of HRCSL, Patricia Narsu Ndanema, Commissioner Dr. Gassan Abess, Commissioner Simitie Lavalay and the Deputy Executive Executive Secretary, Frederick Kamara spoke to the Nigerian High Commissioner on the mandate and functions of HRCSL, the protection of workers rights, foreign nationals, businesses and areas of collaboration.

The Nigerian High Commissioner, Dr. Habiss Ibrahim Ugbada expressed gratitude for the collaborative engagement with the HRCSL whilst highlighting the bi-lateral relations between Sierra Leone and Nigeria.

Dr. Ugbada made mention of the protection of the rights of everybody in the country without fear or favour and also those of the businesses of Nigerians. He committed that the Nigeria High Commission will partner with the HRCSL in its functions and any matter involving its nationals.
