Educational Research. He is educated in Project Management Monitoring and Evaluation. He Lectured Information and Communication Management part-time at Fourah Bay College, University of Sierra Leone (2010-2012) and Business Management at the Port Loko Teachers College in the Technical and Vocational Department (2006-2008).

Mr. Kamara holds a Masters of Philosophy in Library, Archives and Information Studies, a Bachelor of Arts with Honours in Library Studies and a Diploma in Library Studies from the University of Sierra Leone. He also holds a Postgraduate Diploma in Human Resource Management from the Fatima Institute, Makeni. He served as head of the Port Loko Teachers College Library from 1995-2011. He was appointed Research and Documentation Officer, Human Rights Commission of Sierra Leone (2012-2014), Director of Education, Communication and Training, Human Rights 2014-2019 and became Deputy Executive Secretary of the Human Rights Commission of Sierra Leone in November, 2019.
